Dress. Dress for men and women is casual for all events, so bring comfortable clothing and walking shoes. Please plan to layer your clothing. It is advised to bring an umbrella and a water repellent jacket. There is a rooftop open air swimming pool and jacuzzi at the hotel for those who want to bring their swim gear.
