In that same year, I decided to join the Honolulu Valley of the Scottish Rite as well as the Aloha Shrine of the Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine. This was all done while I was a Psychology Major and working at the Polynesian Cultural Center as a Japanese Tour Guide to help pay for my education.

After a year or two in paradise, I made the decision to return to the Mainland where I continued my education at Purdue University in West Lafayette, Indiana. While I was at Purdue, I enjoyed an affiliation with the West Lafayette Lodge where I was able to observe some of the struggles Masonic Lodges have experiences in the area of dwindling Membership and inspired me to start thinking on how as a younger brother, I could maybe help. Following marriage and during these significant changes in my life, I served as Commander of the Santa Monica Bay Commandery #61 in 2012 and High Priest of Santa Monica Bay Chapter #97 in 2013 and lastly, Illustrious Master of Orange County Council #14 in 2015. Before my time as Illustrious Master in 2013, I served as an Inspector for the

Grand Commandery of California for Department 2 and bridging my time as Illustrious Master from 2014-2016 I served as the Assistant Directors of Ritual for Department 2.

Another thing happened during this time, in addition to joining the Royal Order of Scotland, St. Thomas of Acon, The Operatives in Salt Lake City, the Knights Masons, York Right College where I served as Governor 2016-2017, AMD where I served as Sovereign Master in 2014.
